**Antalya, Turkey**

**12 May – 21 May 2011**

## 1. Technical Committee

The technical committee will be composed of the EDSO Technical Officials and members appointed by the Organizing Committee (OC):

## 3. Commissioner

3.1. The European Deaf Volleyball Championships must be under the commission of a responsible person, appointed by the Volleyball Association of the host country.

3.2. The commissioner must cooperate with the EDSO TO on Volleyball and look for observation of FIVB and CEV Rules.

## 4. Technical Meeting

4.1. The Technical Meeting will be held one day before the beginning of the Volleyball-EC.

4.2. The Technical Meeting will have two different dates and time:

4.2.1. First meeting will be on 11 May at 21h00 in the Meeting Room in the Hotel Ozkaymak FALEZ, Konyaalti Falez Mevkii Pk 8, 07050 Antalya.

From 20h00 : check application – contribution in the Meeting Room.

4.3. The meeting will be conducted in International Signs only.

4.4. Each participating National Federation may be represented by two officials, of whom at least one should be deaf.



## 5. Competition Venue

## 6. Training Venue

The training sites are the same as the competition venue. The OC ensure themselves the planning of the trainings.

## 7. Schedule

Refer to competition schedule included on the EDSO site.

## 8. General Rules

- 8.1. The volleyball competitions will be organized in accordance with the new Edition of Rules of the FIVB and CEV 2009.
- 8.2. Any unforeseen occurrences not covered by the rules shall be regulated as follows:
  - 8.2.1. Cases of general nature shall be regulated in accordance with the EDSO Statutes and Regulations. In case of collisions between versions at different languages, English text shall prevail.
  - 8.2.2. Technical questions shall be settled according to FIVB and CEV Rules. In case of collisions between versions at different languages, English text shall prevail.
  - 8.2.3. Only athletes who comply with the EDSO Rules and Regulations are entitled to take part in the European Deaf Volleyball Championships.

## 9. Participants

- 9.1. Each National Deaf Federation may enter a maximum number of one (1) men's team and one (1) women's team.
- 9.2. Each team may have fourteen (14) players (12 regular players + 2 libero) and five (5) officials



by registration final list. (See regulations FIVB 4.6.4 with possible team registration : 12 players + 2 libero, 12 + 0, 11 + 1, 10 + 2, 11 + 2). On the Final name registration for 10/04/2011 there also place for 6 reserves. See also 9.3.

9.3. No reserves or substitutes are allowed after the first technical meeting of 11 May 2011.

9.4. Players under 18 must a written admission have of their parents or tutor and national deaf sport federation.

## 10. Medical Control

## 11. Sportswear

11.1. All competitors have to wear sportswear of their home country. Wear design must follow with FIVB Rules 2009.

11.2. Participants must observe the regulations of the FIVB and EDSO regarding advertising on sportswear etc.

11.3. Each team must have at least two sets of uniforms in contrasting colors (one light and the other dark). Players must wear the same number as on the entry form throughout all games.

11.4. Each contestant takes part in the competitions at his/her own risk.

## 12. Protests

12.1. In case of protest, the Captain of the protesting team must sign the score sheet in the space marked "To be signed by Captain in case of protest". The official representative of the team must then within 20 minutes confirm the protest in English writing without giving detailed explanations and hand it over to the Technical Committee together with a deposit fee equivalent to 50 Euros.

12.2. The protest must be made in detail in English written within one hour after ending the game. If the protest is granted the deposit fee will be handed back. Otherwise it will be kept to the benefit of the EDSO.

12.3. In case the protesting team or the opposing team is not satisfied with the decision of the

Technical Committee, then an appeal may be addressed to the Jury of Appeal immediately together with a deposit fee equivalent to 100 Euros.

12.4. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final.

### 13. Technical Equipment

13.1. The technical equipment shall be provided by the host country in accordance with the Rules of the FIVB 2009.

13.2. Host country must provide for tournament balls "Mikasa" MVA 200 approved by FIVB. (three balls for one court + reserve)

### 14. Officials

14.1. The Referee and Head Referee must be of highest standard that is either FIVB-referees or appointed by the Volleyball Association of the host country to referee games in the highest league of the Association.

14.2. EDSO have the power himself send referees to the EC which satisfies to the level and with admission of their national federation volley ball.

14.3. Referees and their assistants shall conduct the games in accordance with the rules and official FIVB interpretations of such rules. The English text shall prevail.

### 15. Competition rules and regulations

15.1. Games System is identical to men's and women's tournament.

15.2. According to Draw all teams will be divided in groups A and B and play tournaments in groups by round robin system.

**Pre-quarter final Women:** WA4 – WB5

**Quarter finals Women:** (1)QF: A1 – B4, (2)QF: A2 – B3, (3)QF: A3 – B2, (4)QF: A4/B5 – B1

**Quarter finals Men:** (1)QF: A1 – B4, (2)QF: A2 – B3, (3)QF: A3 – B2, (4)QF: A4 – B1

**Semifinals:** winner (1)QF - winner (3)QF, winner (2)QF - winner (4)QF

**Places 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>:** (1)5/8: loser (1)QF - loser (3)QF, (2)5/8: loser (2)QF - loser (4)QF

**Finals:** winners semifinals

**Places 3<sup>rd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup>:** losers semifinals

**Places 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>:** loser (1)5/8 - loser (2)5/8

**Places 5<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>:** winner (1)5/8 - winner (2)5/8

Other teams in games struggle for:

Men: A5 – B5 play for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> place.

Women: loser Pre-quarter final becomes 9<sup>th</sup> place.

### 15.3. point system pools (Regulations competition CEV 4.7.2)

- 15.3.1 The ranking of teams is determined by the results of matches on the basis of matches won and lost.
- 15.3.2 Points awarded per match to each team:  
Match won: 2 points  
Match lost: 1 point  
Forfeit: 0 point
- 15.3.3 In case of equality in the number of points gained by two or several teams, they will be classified in descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of the number of all sets won by the number of all sets lost.
- 15.3.4 If the tie persists, as per the set quotient, they will be classified in descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by the total of set points lost during all sets.
- 15.3.5 If the tie continues, as per the sets points quotient, the teams are decided between by the result of the match(es), which the teams have disputed between them.
