2. PLAYING CATEGORIES OF THE EDGC

2.1 Men's Tournament

The Men's Individual Tournament shall be 54 holes of stroke play over three rounds. If two or more players have equal results after the final round, there shall be a playoff until there is a winner.

Handicap limits are set for entering the Men's Tournament:

- **14.0** for all players who forms a part of their National Team of 5 members.



2.2 Men's Team Tournament

The men's team competition shall be a stroke play tournament. A team shall consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 golfers.

Every day, the three best scores in the team shall be summed. The team with the lowest total score after three days will be the winning team.

Only two teams per nation is allowed to play.

2.3 Women's Tournament

The Women's Individual Tournament shall be 54 holes of stroke play over three rounds. If two or more players have equal results after the final round, there shall be a playoff until there is a winner.

Handicap limits are set for entering the Women's Tournament:

- **24.0** for all players who forms a part of their National Team of 3 members.

2.4 Women's Team Tournament

The Women's team competition shall be a stroke play tournament. A team shall consist of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 golfers.

Every day, the two best scores in the team shall be summed. The team with the lowest total score after three days will be the winning team.

Only two teams per nation is allowed to play.

2.5 Senior Men's Tournament

Senior Men's Tournament is open for men who shall have reached their 50th birthday at least one day before the start of the tournament. The Senior Men's Tournament shall be 54 holes of stroke play over three rounds. If a golfer enters the Senior Men's tournament, he may not enter the Men's Tournament.

If two or more players have equal results after the final round, there shall be a playoff until there is a winner.

Handicap limits are set for entering the Senior Men's Tournament:

- **18.0** for all players who forms a part of their National Team of 4 members.



2.6 Senior Men's Team Tournament

The Senior Men's team competition shall be a stroke play tournament. A team shall consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 golfers.

Every day, the three best scores in the team shall be summed. The team with the lowest total score after three days will be the winning team.

Only two teams per nation is allowed to play.

2.7 Senior Women's Tournament

Senior Women's Tournament is open for women who shall have reached their 50th birthday at least one day before the start of the tournament. The Women's Senior Tournament shall be 54 holes of stroke play over three rounds on the same tees as the Women's. If a golfer enters the Senior Women's tournament, she may not enter the Women's Tournament.

If two or more players have equal results after the final round, there shall be a playoff until there is a winner.

Handicap limits are set for entering the Senior Women's Tournament:

- **28.0** for all player who forms a part of their National Team of 3 members.

2.8 Senior Women's Team Tournament

The Senior Women's team competition shall be a stroke play tournament. A team shall consist of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 golfers.

Every day, the two best scores in the team shall be summed. The team with the lowest total score after three days will be the winning team.

Only two teams per nation is allowed to play.

2.9 Male Junior Tournament

The Male Junior Tournament is open for players who are not older than 21 years of age on the last day of the competition, and have an official handicap of **18.0 or under**.

The Junior Tournament shall be 54 holes of stroke played over three rounds. If a male participant enters the Junior Tournament, he may not enter the Men's Tournament.



2.10 Female Junior Tournament

The Female Junior Tournament is open for players who are not older than 21 years of age on the last day of the competition, and have an official handicap of **30.0 or under**.

The Junior Tournament for females shall be 54 holes of stroke play over three rounds. If a female participant enters the Junior Tournament, she may not enter the Women's Tournament.
