The badge as well as any necessary document will then be given to you by a person in charge of the Organizing Committee.

3. Official Hotel

For those who have opted for the official hotel, a person of the Organizing Committee will tell you where the facilities are located (rooms, race office, team manager's meeting, ,swimming pool - do not forget your swimsuit, Bike storage, ...).

Within the hotel, it will not mention any display indicating such location. This for security reasons with regard to third parties.

If you change your reservation or cancelled it we will not pay back the hotel reservation fees.

Although Bike storage will be secure, we can ask you to bring your own lock.

A shuttle will be available throughout this sporting event.

4. General information (for all participants)

All registered participants must always bring their personal badge to access the shuttle (if official hotel), any meals ordered and within the Restricted Zone Area.

Officials (max : 2 per participating National Federation) who have not opted for the official hotel have the possibility to benefit from transportation from the Sports Complex to the hotel where the Technical Meeting will take place.

A daily schedule will be distributed on site every day to all participants (who stay at the official hotel or in another rental).

The banquet on Saturday 12 May in the evening will be offered to all these participants.
