From 2023 at Deaflympics 2025

For participation in Deaflympics 2025, we are setting up a ranking and qualification system in order to clearly define the number of athletes per weight category, per country, per event and setting up a table with points according to the ranking per event to have heads series of each and will be used before the draw during the 1st technical meeting.

The criteria of the ranking and qualification system are:

1) Number of Athletes per Event

To participate in :

- 1.1) The continental championships and the world championships : A maximum 2 (two) athletes per category and per country
- 1.2) The Deaflympics :1 athlete per category and per country (The best athlete)
- 2) The organization of the heads of series
