

#### The city of Málaga

Monuments such as the Alcazaba, the Gibralfaro Castle, the Roman Theater or the Atarazanas market take us to a fertile past. Numerous museums such as the Picasso, the Thyssen or La Térmica, a center open to the latest trends in art, show the effervescence of a city that is committed to culture.

In recent decades, the city of Malaga has made a great effort to value all its historical and artistic heritage. Today Málaga is one of the most sought-after cultural destinations internationally due to the quality of its offering, among which there are 37 museums with a very varied theme.







The east pushes the surface water, which is warmed by the sun, towards the coast. On the other hand, the westerly winds, which bring the dreaded land, cause the opposite effect, since they drag the surface layer out to sea and it is replaced by deep waters, which are colder.

In Malaga capital there are 15 beaches with 13.5 kilometers of length along the coastline that reaches 17.5 kilometers. In this extension there are 140 showers, of which eight are for people with reduced mobility.









## WEATHER




The temperature in Malaga in the summer months ranges between 23°C and 25°C, and rain is practically non-existent.

Malaga is bathed by the Mediterranean Sea and is the capital of the Costa del Sol

The climate is Mediterranean with mild winters and warm summers. Malaga has an annual average of 300 days of sunshine and only 50 days of rain.

The hot season lasts 2.9 months, from June 17 to September 15, and the average daily maximum temperature is more than 28 °C. The warmest month of the year in Malaga is August, with an average maximum temperature of 30 °C and minimum temperature of 21 °C.


