
BYDGOSZCZ CITY

Bydgoszcz (*Bydgostia*) is a city in northern Polan, on the Brda and Vistula rivers. With a city population of 358,614 (June 2014), and an urban agglomeration with more than 470,000 inhabitants, Bydgoszcz is the eighth-largest city in Poland. It has been the seat of Bydgoszcz County and the co-capital, with Toruń, of the Kuyavian-Pomeranian Voideship since 1999. Prior to this, between 1947 and 1998, it was the capital of the Bydgoszcz Voivodeship, and before that, of the Pomeranian Voivodeship between 1945 and 1947.


VENUE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Forest Park of Culture and Recreation in Bydgoszcz (LPKiW), also: Myślęcinek - the largest urban park in Poland, with 830 hectares of land, located in the northern part of Bydgoszcz, 5 km from the city center. It is colloquially called "the park in Myślęcinek" from the name of the part of the city in which it is located.


